2. Empowering the women of rural areas to become self-sustained and fight for their rights.
3. Fulfilling housing, healthcare, education and all other basic requirements of children who are in need for it.
4. Making people aware of the need to save the environment and doing part of the responsibility.
5. Educating people in the rural areas on the need for undergoing regular medical checkups and taking initiatives to organize them ourselves.

My Home

This is a children home where we are taking care of 6 children giving them all the basic facilities like food, shelter, clothing, education and health support. These children are either single parented or completely orphaned. We provide a proper system to take care of their requirements. We send them to a nearby school for all their educational needs.



Children of My Home



This little girl is Dhanushree aged about 7 years. She is studying in 2nd Std. She has a younger brother who is about 2 years. Her mother is struggling very much to take care of the child as she doesn't have any support from the father. She is a very cheerful child and always sees that all the children are happy.

This girl with a sweet smile is Archana aged about 7 years. She is studying in 2nd std. She has two elder sisters and one among them is with us in "My Home". Her father has abandoned the family and the mother was struggling to take care of three kids. However she is working as a cook with us and the children are taken care here. She is very active child and very good at singing.

This boy is Sagar aged about 8 years. He is studying in 3rd std. A single-parented child whose mother works as a house maid. She was not capable enough to even feed the child. Sagar is very good in all the activities and he is always the class topper.

This is Akash aged about 8 years, studying in 3rd Std. A single parent-ed child. He has a elder brother who is here with him. His mother had planned to admit both the children in different NGOs but we thought that the two children should not be departed and both are here with us. A hyper active child who cheers all the other children.

This is Aneesh, aged about 9 years, studying in 4th Std. He is the elder brother to Akash. He is a child with a very good matured thoughts. Acts responsible about the other children, very good at studying and helping other kids.

This is Keertana, aged about 13 years, studying in 7th Std. She is the elder sister of Archana. As the eldest kid among all the children, she is a very responsible child and helps all the children to do their day to day works. She is very good at drawing and painting.



Vidya Spoorthi

This is a unique education empowerment program which caters to the rural and underprivileged children to study uninterruptedly by providing the schooling material. We adopt the bad shaped schools to rejuvenate it to life and help the students to continue studies. 

Highlights of the Year

- A new initiative:

This year, we gave a kickstart to a new project of our organisation called "My Home", which is an undertaking for children who are either orphaned, single-parented or belong to a poverty-stricken family. It is currently providing full sponsorship with regard to shelter, clothing, education and medical facilities to 6 children.

- Widespread of Vidya Spoorthi:

We managed to distribute stationary to more than 200 students in the rural areas of Bangalore this year. We were successful in collecting sufficient quantities of books, pencils, pens, erasers and other things and distribute them to the children.

- Toy Distribution at IGICH:

This event consisted of distribution of toys to the children of Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health which we got as donations from some generous donors.

- Plant a tree!:

This event was conducted under our project on environmental protection called "Prakruti". In this event, we planted 200+ saplings in the remote areas in the outskirts of Bangalore with the help of our extremely energetic volunteers.



Volunteering Actions

Individual volunteering can be categorised in two different channels:-

1. **Direct Volunteering:**

In this the individual will be involving himself or herself with the direct activities or the partnered activities of the organisation. The schedule will be communicated to all the volunteers and their interest of service will be known and the tasks will be deputed accordingly.

2. **Indirect Volunteering:**

In this the individuals who are interested to show their *kritagyata* towards the society and the time factor is stopping them to do so. We encourage them to write the content, creating newsletters, publishers etc., and help us in building the website and helping us technically.

Infrastructure and Development

Last year, we succeeded in establishing our name in the society by starting off with our project. We managed to conduct a few activities under our “Vidya Spoorthi” project.

However, this year, we started something extremely different and much more impactful called as “My Home” in which we provide basic amenities such as food, shelter, clothing, education and healthcare of those children who are deprived of it. We started off with taking up the responsibility of 5 children and succeeded in providing them with complete nurturing.

Under this project, we had to keep in mind the general requirements such as a site for undertaking it, funds required for expenses including the children’s schooling, medical care, groceries, clothing, stationary, etc. We took a piece of property on lease where we still continue to reside these children under the constant attention of a full-time care-taker. We also invite people from outside to make their special occasions memorable by celebrating them with these children.
